DUMPSTER DO'S AND DON'T'S For Lakewood residents only

DO: Distribute items in dumpsters evenly.

DO: Place furniture into dumpster. Use another bin if the first one is full.

DON'T: Overfill the dumpsters. They cannot be serviced if overfilled!!!

DON'T: Put mattresses, box springs, or carpets in the regular dumpsters.

The dumpsters at the Shell Station will be used for recycling Mattresses, Box Springs, and Carpets.

DON'T: Dump auto parts/TVs/refrigerators/air conditioners/computers/laptops/tablets/
construction debris or business waste.

DON'T: Dispose of syringes in bins. Place them into an approved sharps container and drop off
at the red metal container at the SMaRT Station (for FREE!)

DON'T: Put paint, motor oil, or other household hazardous waste into Dumpster.

You can put paint cans with the lids off and the paint completely dry in the dumpsters. If you have unused paint that is still good, you can drop it off at the SMaRT station and they will recycle it!

If you have motor oil, you can put it out with the regular garbage pick-up. Just place the oil in one-gallon or smaller, CLEAR plastic container with screw-top lid. Place oil filter in a CLEAR, zip-locked plastic bag. Place oil container and filter on curb next to recycling cart on service day. After pick-up, a replacement container/bag will be provided by the collection driver. Call Utilities Customer service (408) 730-7400 to request container/bag or if no replacements left.

DON'T: Dispose of electronic devices, small appliances, televisions or computer monitors,
fluorescent lights, or mercury thermometers.

All of these items may be recycled at the SMaRT Station seven days a week throughout the year
by Sunnyvale residents at no cost!!!
